## Highlights of the holiday adventure include: CAPE TOWN

Cape Town is simply stunning, but the city does not thrive by its looks alone. Proudly multicultural, its flourishing arts, dining, and nightlife scenes are proof of this modern metropolis' creativity and innovative spirit. To begin your wine experience, you will enjoy a tour of the storied <u>Constantia wine area</u> nestled in the suburbs of Cape Town. Constantia Valley is the oldest wine producing region in the southern hemisphere with an uninterrupted history of winemaking since 1685. Your tour package also includes a cable car ride and visit to the iconic Table Mountain plus a visit to the famous Victoria and Alfred Waterfront and a tour to Cape Point, the Southernmost point in South Africa. As well, you have the option during your free time to take in Robben Island, the infamous home of Nelson Mandela for 18 of his 27-year prison sentence.

## FRANSCHHOEK/ STELLENBOSCH

Franschhoek was founded in 1688 by French Huguenots. It is renowned for not only its wine but its world class restaurants. We will introduce you to unforgettable cellar door experiences, award-winning wine estates and celebrated restaurants.

At nearby Stellenbosch – South Africa's second oldest town and most inspiring wine, food, art, and cultural destination – we will explore wineries in the scenic <u>Stellenbosch Wine Route</u>. This <u>wine route</u> is the oldest in the country and one of the most popular destinations for local and international visitors alike. Other optional things to do in the area include biking through the vineyards, hiking or mountain biking in the surrounding hills and exploring the markets and shops in the historic town centres of Franschhoek and Stellenbosch.

## HERMANUS

Stretched along a narrow ribbon of land between towering mountains and a spectacular shoreline, Hermanus is surrounded by nature. Sitting on the edge of Walker Bay, this small coastal town offers an array of experiences such as seeing whales, dolphins, great white sharks, penguins and seabirds in their natural habitat, experiencing the most diverse Floral Kingdom in the world, taking a mountain walk, exploring pristine beaches, and visiting a hidden valley so beautiful it is named 'Heaven and Earth.' There is no one activity to single out when it comes to the many things to do in and around Hermanus. Your tour includes a visit to the up-and-coming Walker Bay wine region plus a visit to see penguins of Betty's Bay!

## SABI SABI PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

Adjacent to the Kruger National Park, the Sabi Sand Nature Reserve is a private premier viewing destination. It was the first-ever private nature reserve established in South Africa. The landscape features 65 000 hectares of savannah-covered land interspersed with watering holes, dry river beds, Lowveld woodlands, and the perennial Sabi and Sand rivers. This spectacular reserve offers exceptional game viewing opportunities with frequent sightings of the renowned Big Five

as well as cheetah, zebra, giraffe, and a variety of antelope. Visitors can enjoy excellent wildlife viewing, dining under the stars, guided bush walks and enjoying a stay in some of South Africa's most luxurious safari lodges.

## Preliminary itinerary for the Wine & Wildlife III Experience:

#### Monday January 12, 2026: Capetown

Your South African wine & wildlife adventure begins today. After arrival at Capetown airport you will be transferred to the luxurious <u>Vineyard Hotel</u> to check in and relax. This will be your hotel for the first 3 nights.

Depending on your arrival time, the afternoon will be *free time* to explore the area or relax. Perhaps you might book an optional tour to <u>Robben Island</u>, infamous as the home of Nelson Mandela for 18 of his 27-year prison sentence. Other optional things you can do in your free time are to explore the spectacular <u>Kirstenbosch</u> botanical gardens, the colorful <u>Bo Kaap</u> district or take a tour of District 6 which gives a clear history of apartheid.

In the evening there will be a welcome cocktail reception for you at the Vineyard Hotel to meet your guides and the other tour participants. The reception will finish around 7:00 pm and the rest of the evening is free to explore Cape Town, enjoy dinner on your own and recover from jet lag. After a wonderful night we will tuck in and get ready for the next day.

#### **Tuesday January 13: Capetown**

*Sightseeing day* of beautiful Capetown. Your guided tour for this day will include a cable car ride and visit to the iconic Table Mountain plus a visit to spectacular Cape Point (one of the southernmost points in Africa) and a visit to <u>Cape Point Vineyards</u> for lunch. Along the way will include a stop to see the Penguins. Later in the afternoon, we will have a visit to the famous <u>Victoria & Alfred Waterfront</u>. In the evening you will be free to enjoy dinner on your own in the vibrant restaurant scene of the Waterfront, which is very close to the Vineyard Hotel.

#### Wednesday January 14: Capetown

*Wine tour day.* We will experience and enjoy a guided tour of the storied <u>Constantia</u> wine area nestled in the suburbs of Cape Town. The wine tour day will include a gourmet picnic lunch in the vineyards at one of the wineries.

In the evening you will be enjoy a Winemakers Dinner with the rest of the tour Participants at the spectacular <u>Beyond Restaurant</u> at the <u>Buitenverwachting</u> winery. We will invite one of the leading Winemakers from the area to join us and tell the tales of the wine region for us.

### Thursday January 15: Capetown to Hermanus

Check out of the Vineyard Hotel and load onto our private bus for transportation for the short (2hour) drive to the Marine Hotel in Hermanus. We will stop and see the penguins along the way in Betty's Bay.

Check into the <u>Marine Hotel</u> a 5-star Relais & Chateau with stunning vistas of the Southern Ocean. Afternoon free to walk around town or hit the beaches. Evening free to go to the spa, explore the town or dine where you want to in Hermanus.

#### Friday January 16: Hermanus

*Free day* to explore Hermanus. Option activities include Shark diving, whale watching, Golf, exploring Hermanus' famous craft beers, exploding gin industry or art galleries, hike or bike in the diverse floral fynbos terrain in the <u>Fernkloof Nature Reserve</u> or relax on one of the pristine Blue Flag beaches.

#### Saturday January 17: Hermanus

*Wine tour day* in the spectacular Walker Bay wine region (<u>Hemel en Aarde Valley</u>), including a special vineyard lunch at the wonderful <u>Creation Winery</u>! Evening free to go to the spa, explore the town or dine where you want to in Hermanus.

#### Sunday January 18: Hermanus to Sabi Sabi Game Reserve

Check out of the Marine Hotel for our private bus transfer to Capetown Airport for our Flight to Sabi Sabi Private Game Reserve (Kruger International airport). Cost of flight included in package. After checking in, we will do a late afternoon game drive before dinner.

Departure day after breakfast. We will be driven to Kruger Airport for our flight back to Capetown Airport. Upon arrival in Capetown we will take our private bus and head towards the Lanzerac Hotel in Stellenbosch.

Check into the spectacular Lanzerac Hotel in Stellenbosch for our final, 4-night stay.

*Afternoon and Evening are free* in Stellenbosch with no activities planned but a good time to walk around the historic area and stores. The Lanzerac resort has a famous winery and vineyard on site. They are one of the first producers of Pinotage in South Africa and are highly rated. Feel free to stop in for a tasting while you are there.

#### Thursday January 22: Stellenbosch

Free day to explore the region.

Optional activities include taking a bike ride through the vineyards, Hiking, or mountain biking in the surrounding hills and explore the markets and shops of in the historic town centers. Evening free to dine where you want to in Stellenbosch.

#### Friday January 23: Stellenbosch

*Wine day tour day* of the <u>Stellenbosch</u> and <u>Franschhoek</u> area. We will introduce you to unforgettable cellar door experiences, award-winning wine estates and celebrated restaurants.

Wine tastings and vineyard lunch included. Evening free to dine where you want to in Stellenbosch.

#### Saturday Jan. 24: Stellenbosch

Free day to explore the region.

For the wine keeners, an optional winery and shopping tour to the nearby town of Franschhoek will be available for a small additional cost.

Optional daytime activities include taking a bike ride through the vineyards, Hiking, or mountain biking in the surrounding hills and explore the markets and shops of in the historic town centers.
